
#### **IMPORTANT**










#### STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS

**Step 1:** Measure a 4 x 4m square in the postion you want the gazebo, mark the four corners with chalk or tape. Ensure the pole feet are placed on these markings with even spacing between poles to provide a sound structure.








**Step 3:** Connect the common poles (f) into upper corner poles (a) and (b) as shown. Using spanner (n) provided secure with common bolts.

**Step 4**: Attach the feet (e) into lower leg poles (d) using bolts (j) and tool (m).







#### STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS

Step 5: Unfold the canopy (p).




**Step 6:** Insert the four cover poles (c) along the edges of the canopy. Connect corners of the canopy to the corners of the frame with turnbuckles (o).






#### STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS

**Step 7**: Secure the edges of canopy to frame with elastic bobbles (k). Tighten the turnbuckles (o) by rotating.



**Step 8**: Lift the assembled upper section of the gazebo and inser the lower leg of the gazebo and inser the lower leg poles (d) into the upper corner poles (a) and (b). Secure the connection with bolts and plastic caps (i).



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#### STEP BY STEP INSTRUCTIONS

**Step 9**: Once erect, ensure the Butterfly gazebo is firmly secured to a stable surface, you can use feet bolts (I) if desired.
