

DO NOT twist or knot suspension cords when hanging.




DO NOT exceed the maximum load of 150kgs.



DO NOT leave children or pets unattended in or near hammock.



Hammocks will stretch by 5-10% after the first few uses. Adjustments can be made after each use to keep you and your hammock comfortable.



Allow a minimum of 50cm clearance range around the perimeter of your hammock when in use. (Fig.1)

WARNING: Read instructions before use and keep for future reference. Failure to read these instructions before use can lead to an increased risk of injury. When installing always check with a qualified builder for safety.

Caution And Safety Instructions

- 1. Assembly must be carried out by an Adult.
- 2. Ensure hammock is fully assembled before use.
- 3. DO NOT exceed the maximum load of 150kgs.
- 4. DO NOT climb into hammock feet first.
- 5. DO NOT stand in hammock.
- 6. DO NOT dive into or jump about in hammock.
- 7. **DO NOT** stick your head through the suspension cords.
- 8. Keep suspension cords as straight as possible. **DO NOT** twist.
- D0 NOT use damaged or weakened hammock hanging accessories.
- **10.** Hammocks are not designed for swinging, playing, climbing or to be used as a children's toy.
- 11. DO NOT leave children or pets unattended in or near hammock.
- 12. Hammock fabric, suspension cords and hanging accessories will become worn over time and with use. Always inspect prior to use and DO NOT use if items show signs of damage or weakness.
- 13. Always check the loading capacity before use.
- 14. Keep hammock clear of obstructions.
- 15. Allow a minimum of 50cm clearance range around the perimeter of your hammock when in use (Fig. 1).
- 16. Only use the hammock on level floors with shock-absorbing properties such as carpet or outdoor grass to minimise the risk of injury in case of an accident. DO NOT use on slippery or hard surfaces.
- 17. Never use a free standing brick wall to hang your hammock.
- **18. DO NOT** modify hammock. Hammock must be used in accordance of this manual.
- **19. DO NOT** smoke in or around the hammock. Keep away from heat or flames.
- **20. DO NOT** use whilst wearing shoes, clothing, jewellery or accessories that have a hook and loop fastener.
- 21. DO NOT use near sharp objects.
- **22.** A copy of this manual must be provided should the hammock transfer ownership.

You will require two fixed points, such as a trees, beams, posts, or dyna bolts in brick walls. Consult a qualified builder if unsure. Never use a free standing brick wall to hang your hammock.

Your hammock with require a minimum of 3 metres between fixing points to get the ideal shape. Rope may be needed to attach one end of the hammock, it is recommended to use a double piece to avoid hammock twisting.








Temporary Installations

For temporary installations, such as trees or beams, we recommend using the Two Trees hanging kit.

- 1. Place the cord round the pole or tree, then thread through the figure eight hook.
- 2. Thread the cord through the clamp hook and secure at desired length.
- 3. Repeat process for other side of hammock. Ensure both hooks are secure, place hammock ends over hooks.



Permanent Installations

We recommend using the Two Trees screw eye and hook. Always check with your qualified builder if unsure of safety. For sturdy masonry walls (not air/hollow/single brick, besser block, or free standing walls) a 10mm dyna bolt with larger washer and rope can be used.

Frame Installation

We recommend using the Two Trees Universal Hammock Frame.











- 1. Open the hammock fabric in the centre of the hammock and slowly and safely sit in the middle as you would a chair.
- 2. Gently lie back on a diagonal with your head on the edge of the hammock.
- 3. Bring your feet in and stretch them out, so you are lying on a diagonal. This is the traditional way to relax in a classic style hammock.

NOTE: Do not climb into your hammock feet first.

Caring For Your Hammock

To prolong the life of your hammock it is best to store away when not in use, as the sun and rain will deteriorate the fabric over time. If using near the sea it is important to rinse regularly. Prior to washing your hammock, tie a loose single knot in the suspension ropes at both hanger ends. Machine wash with cold water on a regular cycle using non-bleach detergent. Do not tumble dry. Do not iron. DO NOT use harsh chemicals or solvents. Dry in shade.



Storing Your Hammock

When storing your hammock, make sure the hammock is clean and completely dry.

To prevent tangles in the hammock, place a knot In each suspension rope. Fold the hammock in half, with suspension ropes together. The fold the edges of the hammock to the centre, and roll the hammock up starting with the suspension ropes. Store in a dry place.
