


**PLEASE NOTE:** Tip-over prevention kit included (refer to last step for installation).

### Step 1




Place foot end caps onto the bottom of the 5 legs (E & F). Note upright position. Place shelving brackets (A) onto the legs. A rubber mallet can be used to lightly tap all brackets into the keyholes of the legs. Allow one keyhole free between the foot end cap and the shelving bracket.

### Step 2




Use two shelf brackets (B) for the side brackets using the shelf bracket from Step 1 as a guide for height, followed by shelf bracket (C) as shown in the diagram. Place brace (D) as shown.

### Step 3




Join the upper and lower legs with the connector pins, as shown in the diagram, taking into account upright position. Note: The legs are designed to sit directly on top of each other - don't overlap them. Handy Hint: Flathead screwdriver may be used to tap in connector pins.

### Step 4




Fix brackets (A) so that the top rivet sits on the upper legs and the bottom rivets sit on the lower legs. Repeat with brackets (B) and (C), followed by brace (D) as done previously.

### Step 5



Fix brackets (A, B & C) at the very top allowing room for the MDF board to sit flush against the legs, followed by brace (D) as done previously.

### Step 6



Apply remaining brackets as above to desired height. Ensure that braces (D) are fixed to all shelves.

### Step 7



Place the MDF boards in the shelves. Ensure that they are sitting flush against the edge of the shelf brackets.
